With over 30 years of experience, Supermud welcomes artists and art lovers of all ages to learn in our beautiful, sunlit community studio environment.

STUDIO

Registered students will be assigned a shelf space to store their work, tools, clothes, etc. Students should bring their own towel and apron. ALL work, tools, etc. must be taken from the studio 2 weeks after the end of each term. Smoking is not permitted.

MAKE-UPS

Supermud is not responsible for providing makeup classes or issuing refunds for classes or programs missed as a result of illness, emergency, weather, or other events beyond our control. Please call for updated weather emergency closings. Adult students can make up classes during the semester if there is space in another class. Permission must be obtained from the teacher in advance. We are unable to offer make up classes to children due to space limitations.

FEES

All materials are included in the tuition price. Adult students are charged \$.05/cubic inch to fire their work. **NEW!! There is a \$1.00 minimum charge for firing.** For children's classes, firing fees are included in the tuition. Tuition must be paid in full on or before the first class. **Sorry, no refunds or credits.**

POTTERY CLASSES

SUPERMUD offers lessons in the intimate atmosphere of a working production studio. During each semester, Supermud students receive hands-on instruction with liberal free practice time.

All Levels: Classes cover a wide range of skills including basic hand-building techniques, introduction to the potter's wheel, and glaze techniques. Advanced students will progress in their individual skills. Beginners are welcome!

Children: (Ages 5+) Classes offer hand-building and introduction to the potter's wheel. A wide variety of projects are explored. *(Children's classes do not include open studio hours).*

Parent & Child: A unique opportunity for parents and children to interact in a creative environment.

Private Lessons: Private lessons are offered at all levels and can include hand-building or wheel throwing. Available by appointment.

Financial Aid: A work-exchange program is offered each semester where students trade work for tuition. Students may apply for these positions during registration.

or \$460 for 3 months, one shelf
